Turn four of your lucky numbers into cash!

Ticket cost: \$1 per game

Drawings: Daily at 1 PM, 4 PM, 7 PM and 10 PM PT

How it works

You win by matching your 4 numbers to the draw numbers. How you match and what you match determines your prize.

How to play

Using a Pick 4 game slip, it's as easy as 1, 2, 3, 4.

- 1 Choose your four numbers (0–9) or mark the Quick Pick (QP) box on the game slip.
- 2 Choose your game options. Pick 4 offers seven ways to win.
- 3 Choose your wager amount—\$.50 or \$1. The minimum you can play per game slip is \$1 per drawing.
- 4 Choose the number of drawings in a row you want to play these numbers—up to 12 drawings.

Play The Easy Way

Just say "Give me a Pick 4 Quick Pick" and give the Lottery retailer \$1. Your number will be placed automatically. You'll get a ticket similar to the one below.



Play For Advanced Players: Match in Exact Order

Pick 4SM also offers players the chance to win by trying to match their numbers in the exact order that they are drawn.

- 1 Choose your four numbers (0–9) or mark the Quick Pick (QP) box on the game slip.
- 2 Choose your game options. Pick 4 offers seven ways to win.
- 3 Choose your wager amount—\$.50 or \$1. The minimum you can play per game slip is \$1 per drawing.
- 4 Choose the number of drawings in a row you want to play these numbers—up to 12 drawings.

Play For Advanced Players: Match in Any Order

If you choose to match your numbers in any order, a new element is added to the game. The prize and odds vary depending on which numbers you pick: identical or different from each other. See examples in prize charts.

Any Order Example

Winning Numbers: **1234**

You matched all 4 in any order.

You win \$250

You matched first 3 in any order.

You win \$50

You matched last 3 in any order.

You win \$50



Play Consecutive Games

Advance Play Drawings—you have the option to play your numbers for the following consecutive games. Mark one box.

Game Slip: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 12

ALL 4 NUMBERS IN ANY ORDER

Example	50¢ Wager	\$1 Wager	Odds
1234	\$125	\$250	1:417
If all 4 of your numbers are different from each other, you are playing for these prizes.			
1123	\$250	\$500	1:833
If 2 of your numbers are identical and the other 2 numbers are different, you are playing for these prizes.			
1122	\$500	\$1,000	1:1,667
If you have 2 pair of identical numbers, you are playing for these prizes.			
1112	\$750	\$1,500	1:2,500
If you have 3 identical numbers, you are playing for these prizes.			
Note: A wager of 4 identical numbers can be played only on Option A: All 4 in Exact Order and Option C: Easy 4 Combo.			
Example of possible combinations with 4 different numbers: 1234, 1342, 2341, 3142, 4123, 4321, 1243, 1423, 2143, 2413, 3124, 3412, 4132, 4312, 1324, 1432, 2314, 2431, 3214, 3421, 4213, 4231, 2134			
Example of possible combinations with 2 identical numbers: 1123, 1132, 1213, 1321, 1312, 2113, 2131, 2311, 3211, 3121, 3112			
Example of possible combinations with 2 pair of identical numbers: 1122, 2121, 2112, 1221, 1212, 2211			
Example of possible combinations with 3 identical numbers: 1112, 1121, 1211, 2111

If you have 2 identical numbers, you are playing for these prizes.			
Note: To play 3 identical numbers, choose Option D: First 3 in Exact Order.			
Example of possible combinations with 3 different numbers: 123, 231, 132, 312, 213, 321			
Example of possible combinations of 2 identical numbers: 112, 121, 211			

LAST 3 NUMBERS IN ANY ORDER

Example	50¢ Wager	\$1 Wager	Odds
X123	\$50	\$100	1:167
If 3 of your numbers are different from each other, you are playing for these prizes.			
X112	\$100	\$200	1:333
If you have 2 identical numbers, you are playing for these prizes.			
Note: To play 3 identical numbers, choose Option E: Last 3 in Exact Order.			
Example of possible combinations with 3 different numbers: 123, 231, 132, 312, 213, 321			
Example of possible combinations of 2 identical numbers: 112, 121, 211
